Scratch into the black board surface and your design will appear in indigenous inspired colours. Have fun experimenting with different patterns and marks.




Layered Patterned Landscapes

Bogong moths are fascinating creatures. Learn more about them while making your own, using textured rubbing plates, paper shapes and a variety of colouring media.









